## **PRIVACY POLICY – as of February, 2024**

**Die-Tech Tool and Design Privacy Policy:** Die-Tech Tool and Design (“DIE-TECH” or “we”) respects your individual privacy. This Privacy Policy documents our adherence to the highest industry standards

for the protection of your personal information. By visiting this web site ("Site") or using any of the services offered on the Site, you acknowledge that you accept the practices and policies outlined in this Privacy Policy. This Privacy Policy is effective as of February 22, 2024, applies to information collected through the Site and covers the following areas:

- What personally identifiable information is collected by DIE-TECH through the Site;
- How DIE-TECH uses this information;
- With whom DIE-TECH may share this information;
- What types of security procedures are in place to protect the loss, misuse or alteration of information under our control; and
- How you can correct any inaccuracies in the information.

**1. Information Collection and Use:** DIE-TECH collects information on the Site at two different stages. First, we collect anonymous, aggregate information (such as domain name or IP address) from all visitors to the Site. This type of information is never linked to any personally identifiable information and is only used in the aggregate to generate statistical reports about the use of the Site.

Second, we require the submission of certain personally identifiable information when you use the services available on the Site. For example, your use of your name and e-mail address when using the 'Contact' page.

**2.
